

As the MTX 500/512 is so new, there are few expansions as yet. RS232 interfaces for the two RS232 interface outputs are already an optional extra, as is Pascal as an add-on ROM pack, with FORTH promised for the near future. The range of ports indicates a good choice of add-ons for the future, and the disc options for the machine as listed as 51 and 8in floppy plus Winchester hard discs. The disc operating system is CP/ M, which iis still under development.
